Endow Iowa State Tax Credit

Gifts to permanent endowment funds of the Community Foundation that benefit Iowa charitable causes, are eligible to receive a **25% state tax credit**, in addition to the federal deductions for charitable giving through the Endow Iowa program.

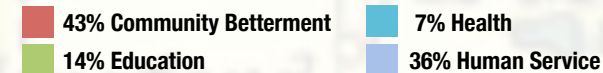
